**Project Description** This new build development completes the North East Quadrant of this landmark development with its centre piece 'Triton Building', the main focal point.

The 'Triton Building' is a 25 storey private residential tower, which features stunning architecture to compliment the surrounding commercial buildings. The use of McMullen's own high performance stick curtain wall design to the North and South elevations is complimented by the use of high performance sliding doors from Hueck to the main balcony areas, whilst a unique and bespoke designed aluminium basket-weave rainscreen façade package complete with McMullen's own high performance windows adorns the East and West elevations. In addition to the main façade works, McMullen are also contracted to provide design, manufacture and installation of the glazed balcony screens, the feature 'toast-rack structure' and all associated roof cladding.

In addition to the 'Triton Building' there is a 9 storey affordable residential block, which will feature a more traditional flat aluminium rainscreen system combined with high performance Hueck sliding doors and McMullen's own high performance windows.

A further feature of the development is the inclusion of a 6 storey premium office block to Brock Street, which will further enhance the commercial office availability in the area. McMullen will be responsible for the design, manufacture and installation of a bespoke unitised glazed façade system complete with bolt on solar shading to maximise the high performance characteristics of the vertical envelope.
